- 4. ECONOMIC SYSTEM Zakah (Alms Giving), Inheritance and No-Riba (Asset-Based Equity Financing and Community Investing.)
- 5. HAJJ Pilgrimage to Makkah The First House Ever Built by Man to Worship God. A Universal State of The Nation Spiritual & Business Conference.

FACTS ABOUT ISLAM

- 1. ISLAM Means to Submit and it is Derived from PEACE The Religion of Peace.
- 2. No Compulsion in Faiths. People are Free to Choose their Beliefs.

FACTS ABOUT ISLAM (contd.)

- 3. Majority of Muslims are Non-Arabs. Indonesia, India, Pakistan and Nigeria Represent Over 65% of the Muslims. The Arabs Represent 20%.
- 4. Islam Refers to the People of the Jewish Faith and Christian Faith as "People of the Book."
- 5. The Crusades are called "The Wars of the Foreigners" in Respect for the Christian Faith.

FACTS ABOUT ISLAM (contd.)

- 7. WOMEN were Given Their Rights to Vote, Participate in Government and Society as Independent Entity and Were Given Right to Own Property and to Inherit.
- 8. Nations of All Faiths, Ethnicities, Cultures and Languages were Created to Know Each Other and to Cooperate, Know and Trade with Each Other

FACTS ABOUT ISLAM

- 9. LIFE is God's Property Interfering with it is Interfering with God's Rights. Suicide and Killing are some of the Worst Sins.
- 10. JIHAD Means Struggle for Excellence towards Spiritual Purity within. Armed Self Defense (in Just War) is its Lowest Expression.

DEFINITIONS

- Allah
 - The Arabic name for God.
- · Qur'aan
 - Collection of all the divine revelations to the Prophet, compiled in a book form.
- Sunnah
 - Teachings and practice of the Prophet.
- Hadeeth
 - Sunnah is recorded in several books of Hadeeth.

DEFINITIONS

- Shari'aa
 - Guidance contained in Quraan and Sunnah.
 - All Islamic law is based on Shariah.
- Figh
 - Islamic Jurisprudence with five major schools:
 - 1 Abu Haneefah 2 Malik 3 Shafai
 - 4 Ibn Hanbal 5 Jafar Sadiq
 - Sunnis follow first four, Shi'aa follow the fifth.

Jihad

- Literally means struggle.
- Best "Jihad" is to improve one's self.
- Fighting is allowed in defense only.
- Explicitly forbidden to start a fight.
- Retaliatory response has to be proportionate.
- Forgiveness and patience to be preferred.

Jihad & Defense

Strict Rules of Conduct for Defensive Fighting

- No Harm to Innocents, Places of Worship and Property
- Prohibited to kill
 - Women
 - Children
 - Old, weak and sick people
 - Non combatants
 - Animals & Plants
